He'll be a four 10 month house arrest with limited exceptions, and then to be 11 followed by a period of probation. He - as the, the facts, I 12 13 think, are well known to Your Honour, and the purpose of the P, 14 the PSR was to show in the background to Mr. Carson that he has been a working and contributing member of society for all of his 15 life. This is a first offence. And the risk to the community, 16 I think, can be managed, if I could put it that way. I, I 17 believe that it's minimal and that can be managed in the terms 18 that we have proposed. 19 20
